

REGISTRATION & MEMBERSHIP TERMS; PARENTAL CONSENT

By signing overleaf I/we agree/consent to the following and to abide by the Club rules, Code of Conduct and Ethos at all times:

- In the event that my son/daughter/dependant is injured whilst playing football or travelling to/from football events and I cannot be contacted on the above numbers, I hereby give consent for my child to receive immediate medical attention.
- I also give my consent for my child to be transported to/from matches and training by the manager/coaches or volunteers associated with the club. Felixstowe & Walton United FC and its representatives are not liable for loss, damage or injury whilst your child is training or playing for the club.
- All kit provided by/via the club remains the property of the club and must be returned to the club on request
- Felixstowe & Walton United FC operates a Club Code of Conduct / A Club Child Protection Policy / An Anti-Bullying Policy and a Club Equal Opportunities Anti-Discrimination Policy. By signing this form you and your child/dependant are bound to observe and act within these Club policies and observe the Rules and Regulations of the Football Association and all competitions in which the Club participates. I consent to disclosure by County Football Associations.
- I agree to the information detailed in this registration form being stored and used by the club purely for administration purposes specific to processing club, league and governing body procedures. I also consent to the club using the information to communicate with me in respect of club/league/other matters/events via email, phone or in writing.

Copies of the club ETHOS, Code of Conduct etc are available from the clubhouse and/or the website.

Each player registration, when accompanied by the appropriate fee, grants automatic membership to the parent/s or guardian/s, for the season concerned (maximum 2 per junior player).

Membership details are as follows, and I/we consent to this membership and agree to abide by the rules of the club and/or its facilities providers at all times.

Felixstowe & Walton United Community Social Club Ltd is a licensed Members Club and as such it is important to remember that rules are in place to ensure we adhere to our licensing conditions for the comfort and benefit of all clubhouse users and our neighbours.

- You must be a Member to purchase any alcoholic drink from the bar or hire the premises.
- Membership is open to all and application forms are available by request from the bar.
- Annual Membership runs from 1st June to 30th May.
- Membership cards must be shown when purchasing any alcoholic drink from the bar or when requested by any official from Felixstowe & Walton United Community Social Club Ltd.
- Visiting players, management and officials will be signed in en-bloc as guests in the members' book.
- Spectators paying the full entry price for Felixstowe & Walton United FC home matches will be given an admission ticket granting temporary membership for the day. These tickets must be shown on request when ordering an alcoholic drink from the bar.

By becoming a member and entering the premises you agree to respect the following rules:

- Children are the responsibility of their parent or guardian and must be supervised at all times. Felixstowe & Walton United Community Social Club Ltd will not be held liable for any incident or accident on the premises.
- Alcohol can only be served during our licensed hours of Midday-11pm.
- Alcohol must only be consumed in the designated areas of the premises. Plastic glasses must be used when drinking outside the immediate vicinity of the clubhouse premises and surrounding area, i.e. pitchside.
- It is an offence to purchase, or attempt to purchase alcohol for, on behalf of any person under the age of 18.
- Please do not attempt to bring your own alcohol onto the premises. Only drinks purchased from the clubhouse may be consumed on the premises (including outside areas).
- Any amplified music must be switched off no later than 11pm.
- Please respect our neighbours by keeping noise to a minimum when leaving the clubhouse, particularly late at night.

The Directors and officials of Felixstowe & Walton United Community Social Club Ltd reserve the right to revoke membership of any person they believe has not adhered to the above rules. The decision of Felixstowe & Walton United Community Social Club Ltd is final. Please also remember these premises are here for the benefit of the community. Please help us to keep a pleasant, clean and safe environment for all members, guests and visitors by using the litter bins provided, only smoking in designated areas and by removing football boots before entering the clubhouse.
