VISITING TEAMS PROTOCOLS Venue- GOLDSTAR GROUND

Version- 6 (2/12/20)

At all times visiting teams and their management, coach's, physios and where allowed spectators must adhere to the current Government Guidelines and FELIXSTOWE & WALTON UTD FC COVID-19 protocols at the time of their visit to the GOLDSTAR GROUND.

Primary points are:

- 1. Anyone that has been in contact with someone isolating or showing symptoms of COVID-19 must not attend or be part of the match
- Any individuals involved with the visiting team playing, coaching staff or supporters that have visited countries on the Government at-risk register must have self-isolated for a period of 14 days and confirm that they have carried out that Government Condition
- Teams arriving must not share vehicles unless members of the same household
- 4. Parking to be at venue car park only, so as to ensure social distancing is maintained
- 5. No more than 6 playing/coaching staff from the team allowed in the Dugout or substitution areas maintain social distancing at all times.
- 6. Players are to keep in their respective bubble for warm up, half time and any drinks breaks
- 7. Physio's / First Aiders to wear masks and gloves when treating players on the pitch
- 8. No Goal celebrations involving hugging, close contact, etc.
- 9. No spitting
- 10. The Clubhouse & bar is closed due to Tier 2 restrictions with hospitality and players food suspended please adhere to the COVID-19 markings and one way routes throughout the ground.

- 11. Where spectators may be allowed (subject to Government Guidance) unless from the same household bubble, they must maintain 2m distance, minimum 1m distance where 2m not practical and in groups of no more than 6.
- 12. Spectators cannot handle the ball if it carries out of play, balls can only be retrieved by playing and coaching staff.
- 13. Changing rooms will be available, but **strictly limited to 6 persons** at any one time (additional changing areas will be made available where possible. Changing rooms should be used as quickly as possible for changing and showering only. Team meetings must take place outside. Changing rooms **MUST** be left in a clean condition.
- 14. Hand Sanitiser is available at all entry and exits points in the clubhouse, including in the matchday players & officials corridor.
- 15. Current guidance is for the host club to not provide drinks in changing rooms or offer hospitality. Visiting clubs should bring their own refreshments.
- 16. Current Government Guidance is to arrive in your kit. Only essential support staff should enter the changing room corridor area.
- 17. By entering our premises you confirm that you will agree to any instruction given to you by a representative of Felixstowe & Walton Utd FC without debate, argument or confrontation to ensure that COVID-19 protocols are maintained.
- 18. NHS Test & Trace posters are located at every entry point and throughout the ground with the QR code to be scanned using the NHS Covid-19 app. A manual system is in place for those unable to use the app.
